The City of Coronado invites sealed bids for the **Coronado Public Library HVAC Controls Upgrades** project. This project consists of pre-construction and post-construction air balancing, HVAC duct repairs, HVAC hardware and software upgrades, and wall and ceiling post-work restorations at the Coronado Library, 640 Orange Avenue, Coronado, California.

Receipt of Bids: All bid proposals must be received by the City Clerk at City Hall, 1825 Strand Way, Coronado, California 92118 PRIOR TO 2:00 p.m. on November 15, 2017.

Engineering Estimate: \$200,000.

Pre-Bid Conference: A non-mandatory pre-bid conference will be conducted at 10:00 a.m., November 8, 2017, at the Coronado Public Library, 604 Orange Avenue, Coronado, California. Contractors to assemble at the project site at the plaza in front of the Library's main entry.

Bid Security: Bid Security in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the Lump Sum Base Bid shall accompany the Bid.

Contractor's License: The successful bidder will be required to possess a current State of California "Class B" Contractor's License at the time the Contract is awarded. Contractors and subcontractors must also be registered with the State of California Department of Industrial Relations per Labor Code Section 1771.1(a).

Prevailing Wage: In accordance with the California Labor Code, the Contractor must pay not less than prevailing wage rates as determined by the Director of Industrial Relations for all work done under this contract. Contractors and subcontractors must also be registered with the State of California Department of Industrial Relations per Labor Code Section 1771.1(a).

The cost (non-refundable) is \$10 per set, not including postage.
